Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine store hiring just 4 people. Total sales for that particular year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various components. During 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to forty workers and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Nowadays, Cascade is among the leading international producers in the material handling business.

Production and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business possibilities. During the last sixty years, the material handling business has matured into a very advanced area and Cascade has proudly played a part in this development. Cascade at present continues to grow as the premier provider of forklift accessories and different related products. The business feels certain in their potential to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the international market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade began designing, manufacturing and promoting hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was done in the year 1956 on a brand new facility to house all plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present center of operations. After fifteen years of business, total staff reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production facility was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry when the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In the year 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing amenities throughout the continental USA to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are made worldwide due to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is designed to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 after acquiring 5 firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in forks.
