

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the fork carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type tine carriages have been consistent.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is something like thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the fork and the fork eye. Various makers will vary the carriages for pin type forks. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
